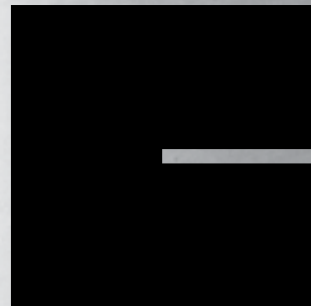
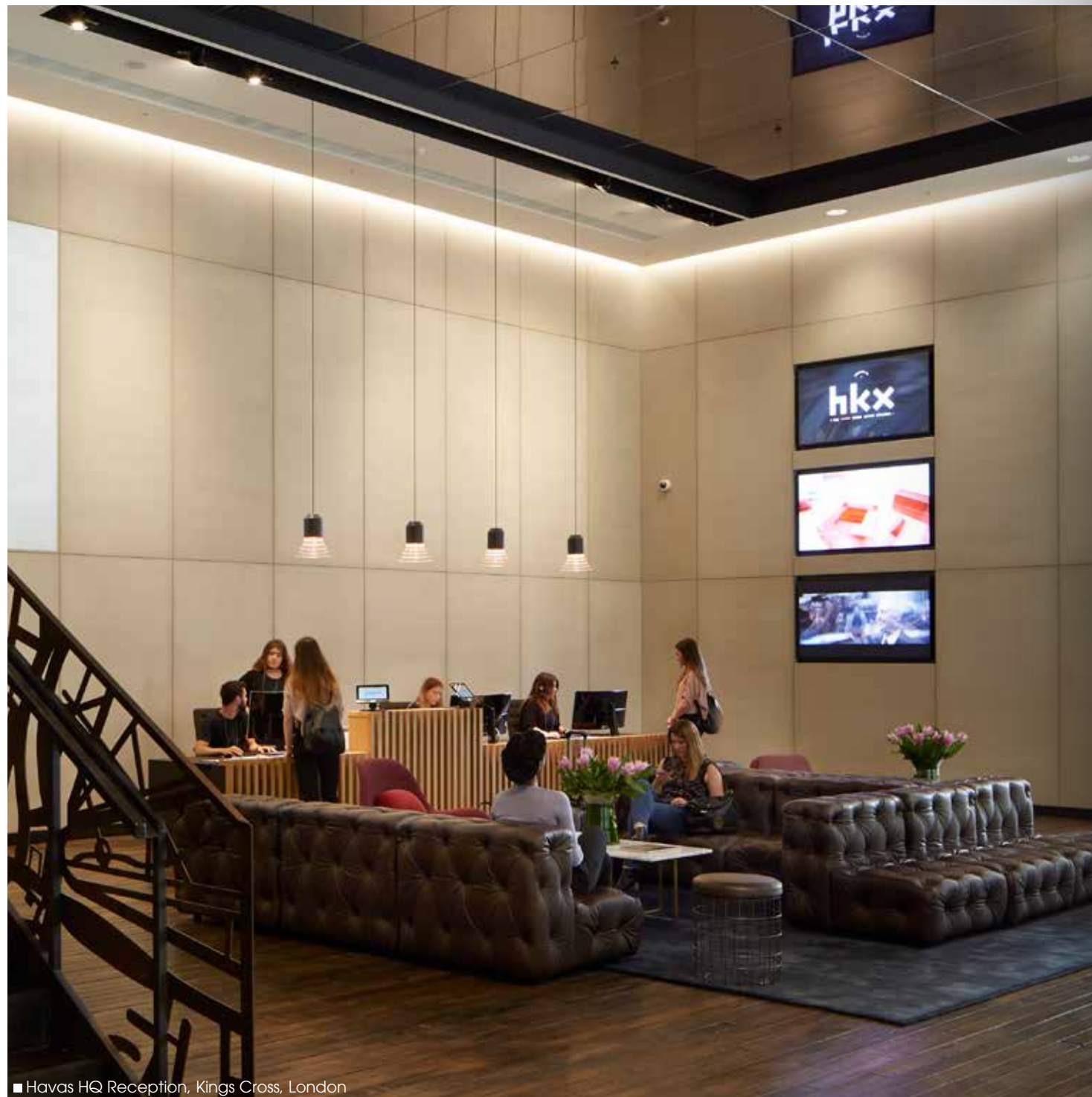

What is Lightweight Cimento®?

Cimento® is applied to a backing substrate, to a thickness of a few millimetres, replicating the strength of concrete cast in a mould. It's produced in a shorter time and weighing considerably less.

Textures

Every panel of Cimento[®] is considered unique. The individual attention to detail during the work process allows the resulting product to display the typical characteristics of concrete, such as patches, spots and streaks, as well as the effects of time.

Smooth

A finish that replicates fair-faced concrete, obtained from a silky-smooth mould. The concrete's porosity is emphasized with small blowholes forming on the surface of the finished panel

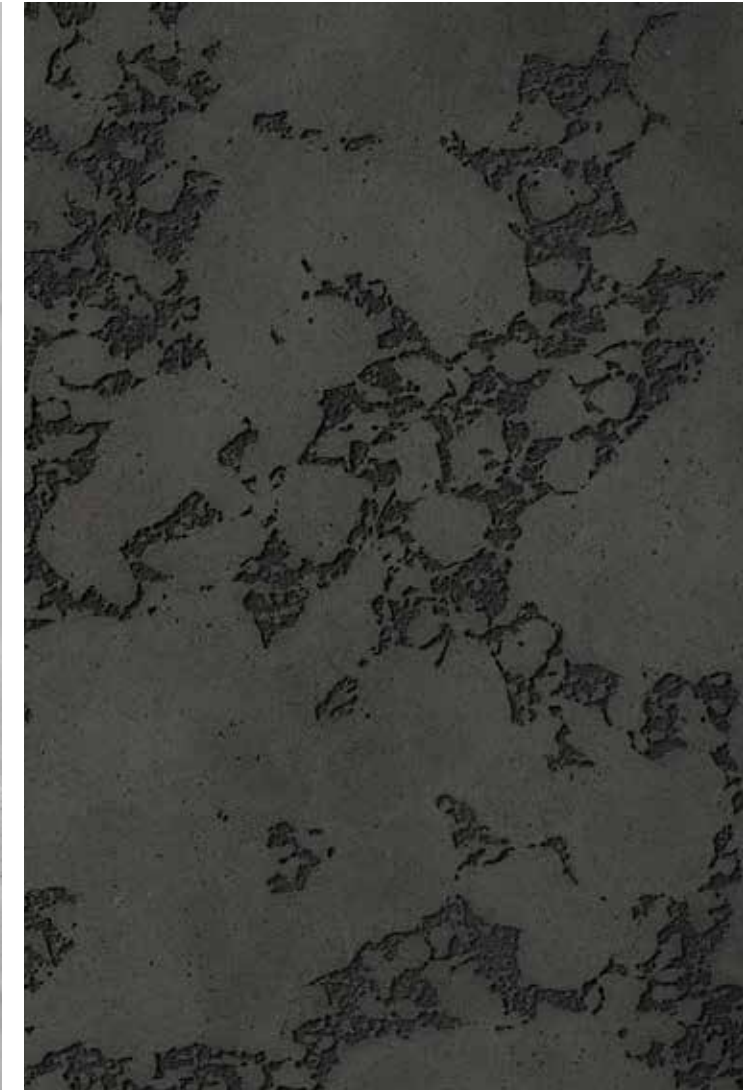
Ando Holes

This finish is inspired by the talented Japanese architect Tadao Ando. It recreates the architectural poetry of the "tie-holes", which is present in all his extraordinary works realized in reinforced concrete, where the "holes" are obtained by the perfect design and positioning of the DYWIDAG bars



Timber Planked

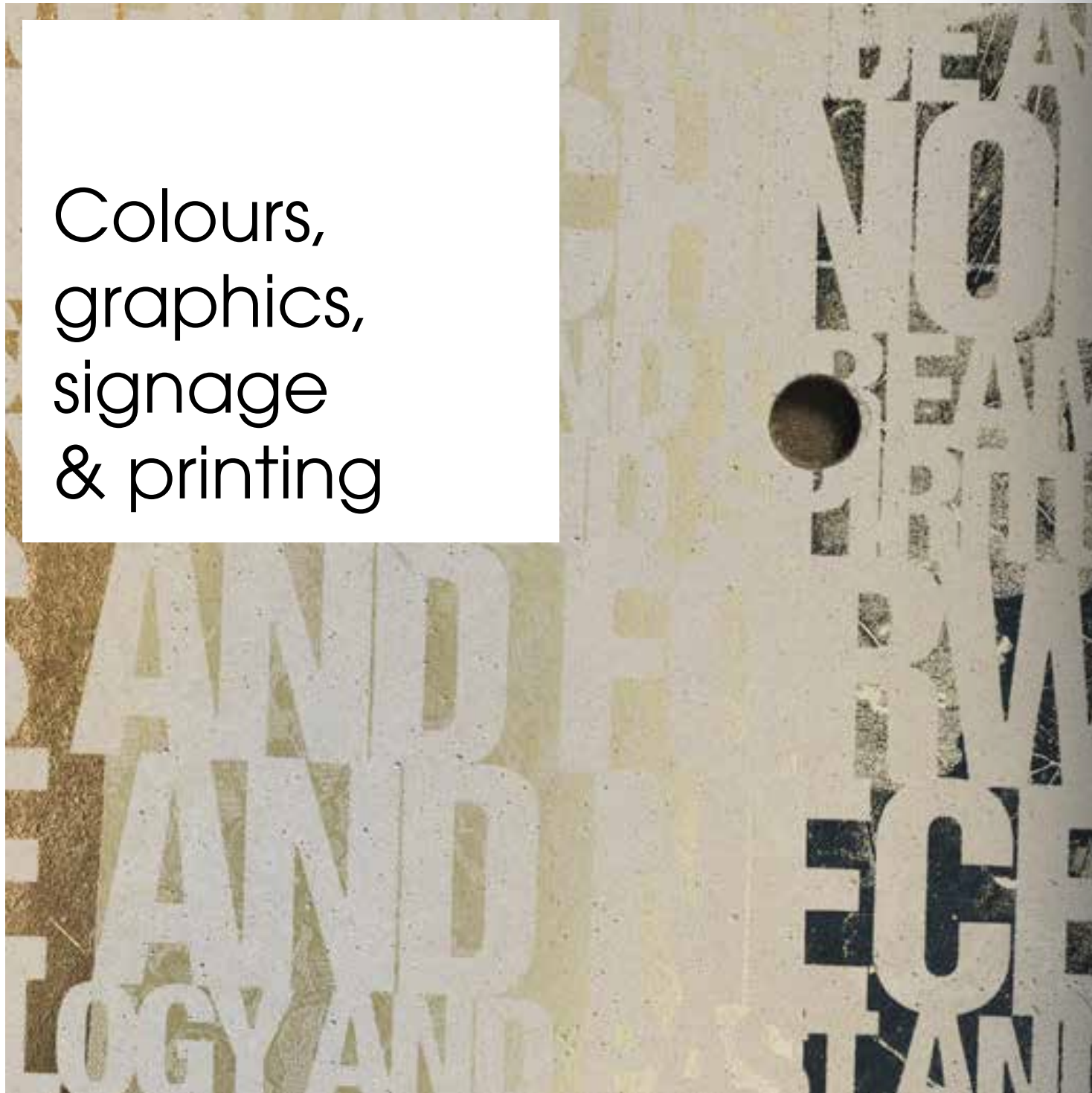
A finish that replicates planks of wood, obtained from a mould made of wooden slabs



Vibrated

A finish replicating irregular coarse concrete, due to the use of chalky stone, clay and silicone sediments

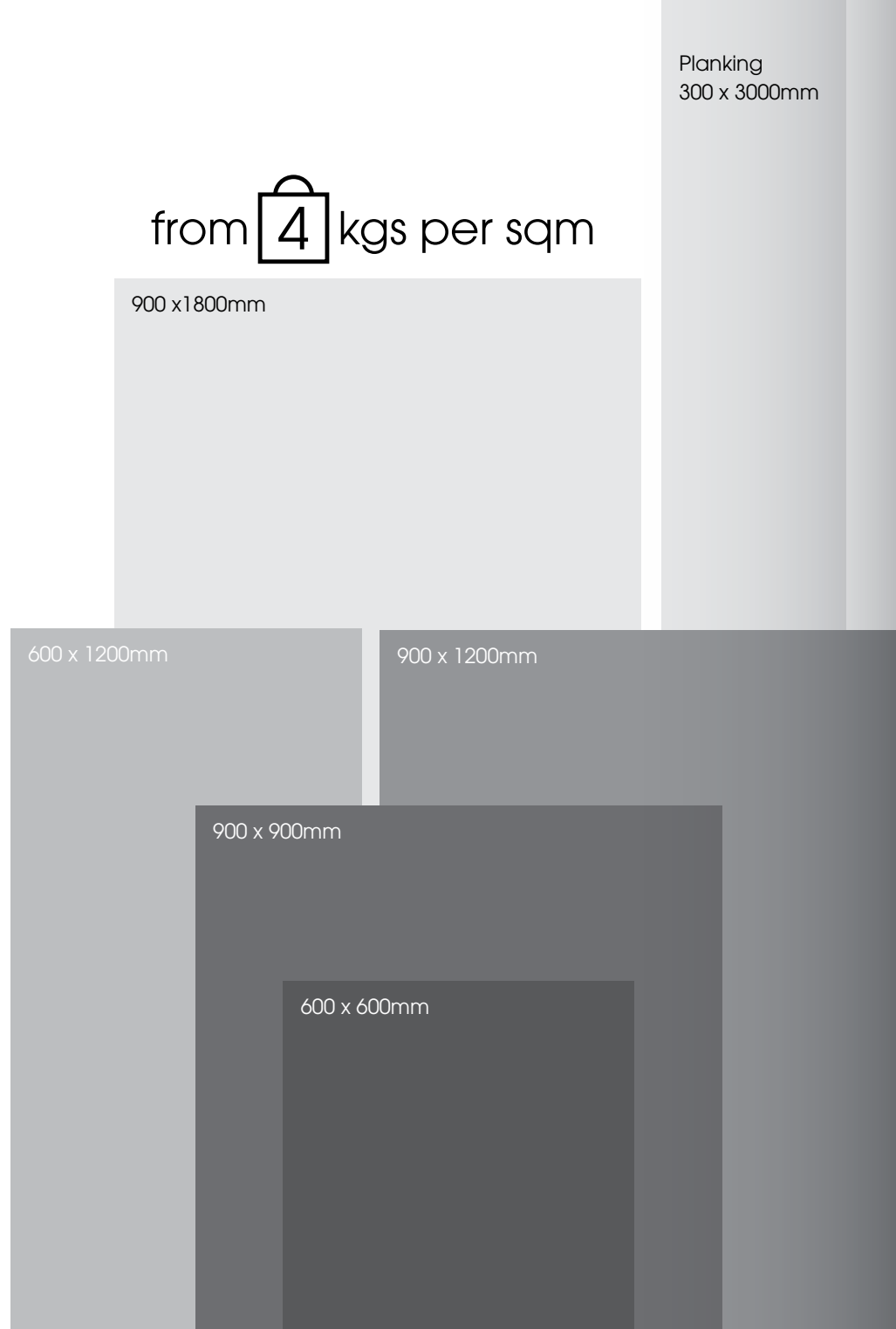

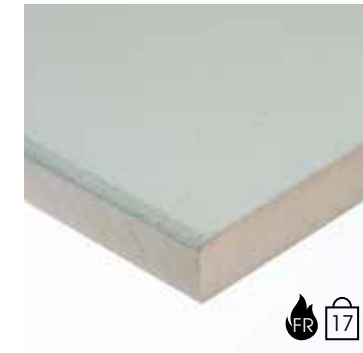

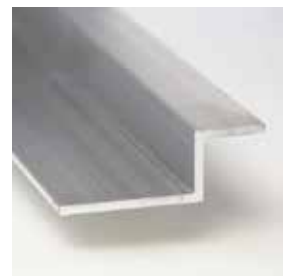


Fixing systems

Cimento® panelling can be fixed in the following ways:

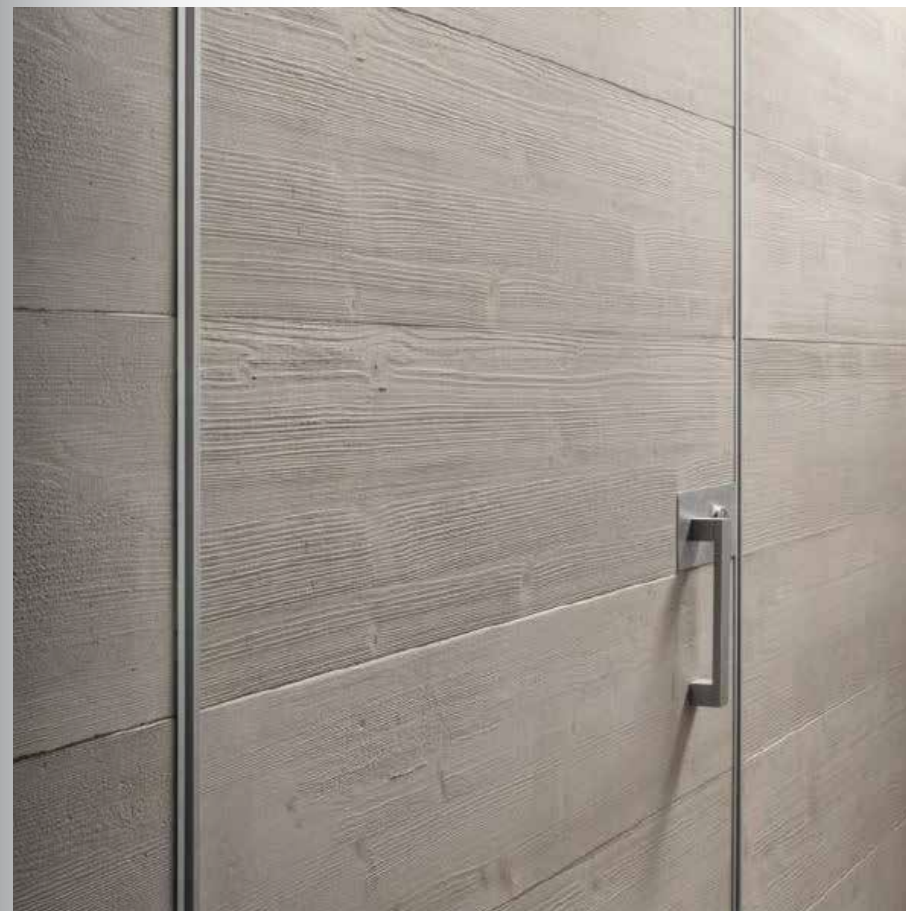
- 15mm Ci Clip system
- 40mm Ci Clip system (great for hiding cabling or insulation)
- 24mm Timber split batten grounds.
- 10mm Aluminium 'Z' bar
- Face fixed screws through Ando holes
- 'T' shaped fixing (for suspending panels from the ceiling)

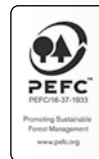




The environment matters to Cimento

Cimento® is a natural concrete mixture with over 90% of its total weight consisting of cement and water. It is not painted or lacquered and is made from the natural elements of oxides, calcium, silicon, aluminium, iron, magnesium and phosphates. Cimento® uses FSC® certified timber backing boards

Cimento® meets Class E1 & EC 1 PLUS for low VOC emissions. We commonly work on Breeam, Lead and ska projects

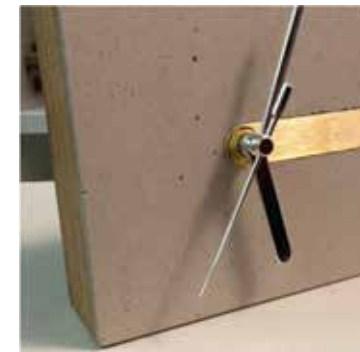

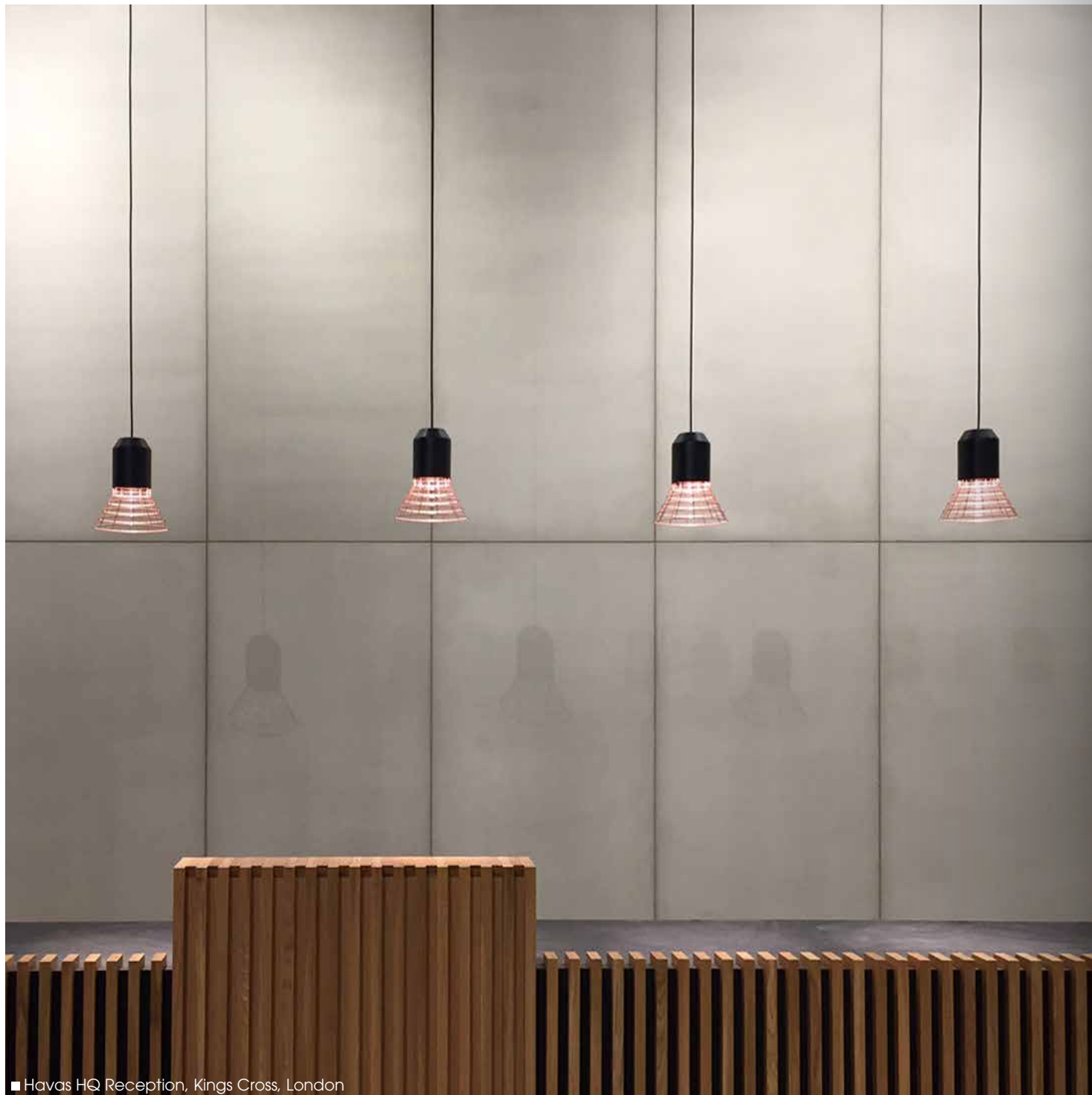

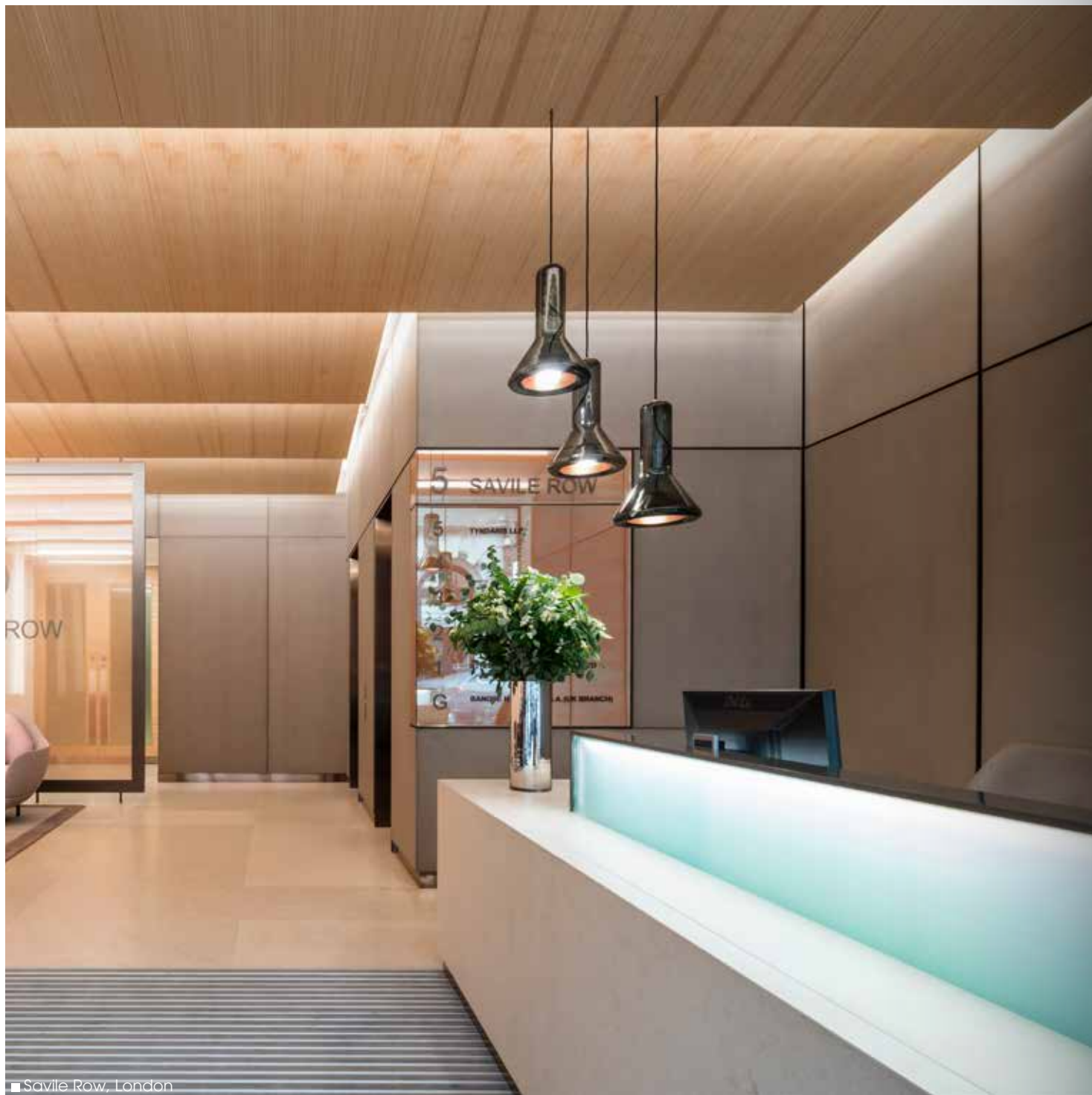

Common questions

How do you cut or drill the material?

The material can be cut and drilled either on site or in a workshop. Circular / skill saws, traditional drill bits and finishing tools can be used to manipulate the material.

What accreditation does **Cemento UK** have?

ISO 18001, 14001 and ISO 9001 management systems. **Cemento UK** has both FSC® and PEFC certificates for supplying sustainable timber. **Cimento®** panels can be supplied as fire rated to achieve Euroclass B (Class 0) fire rating. Cemento UK meets Class E1 & EC 1 PLUS for low VOC emissions will meet BREEAM status for your project. **Cemento UK** provide product data sheets and full project O+Ms on request.

Can I buy it as a sheet material and cut it myself?

We can provide the material in sheet format for you to work as you wish. However, we advise consulting us - **Cemento UK** - before doing so. We can guide you through the best methods of cutting, joining and finishing the material. We collaborate with the best joinery workshops to produce stylish finished projects.

How do you joint the panels?

- 'V' Joint (chamfered edges on each panel)
- Square edge with concrete fill
- Shadow gap detail
- Corner details – Chamfer / 'Bird's beak detail / metal covering trim

How is the surface repaired if it chips?

Cimento® is very durable against general wear and tear. The 2mm of concrete is hard wearing but corners and edges can be chipped if hit by heavy items. We can supply a repair kit that consists of the concrete mix, liquids, sealant and finishing tools to patch any chips on the surface. However, we advise discussing this with us before doing so. Touching up the panels is quick and easy to do once the product is installed on site.

What is the lead time?

The lead time is dependent on the quantity needed and the complexity of the design. For a straight forward panelling product in the most conventional format, a lead time of 4-5 weeks is possible. Up to 10 weeks may be needed from the date of purchase order in the case of **Cimento®** clad doors, reception desks, tea points, copy points, etc. We gauge the time needed for manufacture and advise on a programme once drawings and details have been reviewed.

How much does **Cimento®** cost?

We cost the product on a project by project basis. A square metre price is dependent on a number of points:

- The quantity ordered. There is a minimum order of 10m²
- The support material
- What sealant is chosen
- If 90° corners are required
- The complexity of the design – If it is a reception desk or similar
